Mayor Decision regarding the Power to Veto By-laws

Under the Authority of Section 284.11, being the power to veto by-laws adopted under

- the *Municipal Act* and the regulations, other than under any prescribed section;

- any other prescribed Act or regulation or prescribed section of an Act or regulation

- By-law 121-2025 Partial abandonment of the Donald Pilon, Richemond and South Plantagenet Municipal Drains
- By-law 108-2025 Waste Management Charges
- By-law 122-2025 Confirming Council procedures during its October 27, 2025 meeting
