### Mayor Decision regarding the Power to Veto By-laws

  - By-law 10-2026 Delegation of authority during restricted period
  - By-law 11-2026 to adopt a Use of corporate resources for elections purposes Policy
  - By-law 12-2026 to appoint an Emergency Management Program Coordinator and alternate
