Mayor Decision regarding the Power to Veto By-laws

- By-law 84-2026 - By-law to authorize the construction of Caron - Edwards St Watermains
- By-law 86-2026 -to Authorize Filtration Train Replacement Works at Limoges WTP
- By-law 87-2026 to confirm Council procedures at its April 27, 2026 meeting
