Mayor Decision regarding the Power to Veto By-laws

Under the Authority of Section 284.11, being the power to veto by-laws adopted under

- the *Municipal Act* and the regulations, other than under any prescribed section;
- the *Planning Act* and its regulations, other than any prescribed section; and
- any other prescribed Act or regulation or prescribed section of an Act or regulation

The Mayor hereby: Officially notifies the Council and the Clerk that they waive their right of veto for the following by-law(s):

- By-law 93-2026 - to regulate the height and the description of lawful fences
- By-law 94-2026 - To regulate parking within the limits of The Nation Municipality and to repeal By-law 44-2025
- By-law 98-2026 to establish the 2026 municipal tax rates
- By-law 99-2026 to authorize the acquisition of property for the Pumping Station 12 in Limoges
- By-law 103-2026 to establish the 2026-2030 Joint Compliance Audit Committee and adopt its Terms of Reference
- By-law 104-2026 to Establish a Water Connection Rate for Des Pins Street and repeal By-law 133-2025
- By-law 105-2026 to confirm Council procedures at its June 8 2026, meeting

This Mayoral Decision comes into effect on June 9, 2026.
